74. La localización más frecuente de la trombosis venosa profunda es:

1. Plexos venosos de los músculos sóleos.
2. Sector femoral en el muslo.
3. Sector iliaco.
4. Vena cava inferior.

Introduction

Venous thromboembolism (VTE) incidence increases sharply with age (*Figure 1*) and appears steady over the last 25 years, despite preventive strategies.¹ Women are more often affected at younger ages; this ratio reverses in the elderly.² Incidence is similar in Blacks but lower in Asians.³ Almost two-thirds of VTE cases are isolated deep vein thromboses (DVTs), and 80% are proximal.⁴
